This internship will work with local business, the public and ALT members to increase attendance at organized paddling events, river-based competitions and programs for youth.

Marketing to current members and local businesses, the intern will work closely with the River Recreation Intern to coordinate a range of activities and events for ALT over the summer months with a lot of organizing and cross-promotion across the events.

The intern who is well versed in marketing, social media, public speaking, organization and effective multitasking will do well in this unique opportunity to connect the community to the river.

Responsibilities:

 - a. These events have established structure in place and the intern will work with volunteers, sponsors and staff.
